Completed Works in 2024

JANUARY

AGM calling - incorporated into chairman's letter - saving of over £800 as no printing needed.

Email members – continuing to encourage members to sign up to receive email communication, we now have over 700 email members cost saving on printing of £100

FEBRUARY

Gully - suck - completed

Road sweeping – completed

Insurance – We reviewed our insurance policy, changed companies and made a saving of £2,700

APRIL

Mapping Gullies – We undertook a complete survey of all the roadside gullies that we have responsibility for, these have been, photographed and recorded with individual reference numbers. We now know the exact location and condition of each gully.

JULY

Brook lane – drainage work completed on Brook Lane

OCTOBER

Road Conditions – a survey was carried out on all 75 roads to determine their condition, noting sections that appeared unsatisfactory, photographs were taken of all adverse conditions noted and a severity allocation made.

Flooding - We commissioned expert advice to help us establish with confidence which flooding areas might fall within the FRSA remit, where we would be maintaining existing infrastructure to function as originally installed.

NOVEMBER

CCTV investigation - we have reviewed the reports from this investigation to ascertain where the drains were not working properly due to blockage, broken pipes etc. A programme of remedial works is currently being developed.
